**A Little About Us:**

BFC is a mid-size soccer club based in Belleville, IL on a 30 acre complex which consists of 9 full size fields, 5 small sided fields, a fully lighted Main Soccer stadium and a lighted practice/training area. The complex is complete with access to the Family Sportsplex for indoor league play, winter training, a club house, and a full service office which also hosts the Southern Illinois Soccer League Southern headquarters.

The club is made up of 23 competitive teams, 13 boys teams and 10 girls teams. Our Juniors Program, open to players age 5 – 7 years old, currently has a membership of over 90 players and boasts 3 teams playing in the SISL Developmental league for teams U8 and younger.

Our current staff consists of 23 coaches and 10 trainers licensed at various levels in the USSF coaching education program.

**What We Offer:**

BFC coaches and trainers are offered various compensation packages based on experience and other factors. Compensation may include pay, discounts and apparel or equipment.

**Qualifications:**

Coaching and/or playing experience and a coaching license is required.
